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PROCEDURE FOR THE APPROVAL OF ALTERNATIVE MEANS OF COMPLIANCE

(AltMoC)

1. APPLICABILITY

This AIC shall apply to Air Navigation Service Providers (ANSPs) and Air Traffic control Training Organisations (TOs), hereafter referred to as "organisations", having their principal place of operation and, if any, their registered offices, in the Republic of Cyprus.

2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this AIC is to define the administrative procedure to be followed by organisations, when applying to the NSA for the approval of Alternative Means of Compliance (AltMoC) with the requirements of the regulations referenced in Section 3 below.

3. REFERENCED DOCUMENTS

- Regulation (EU) 2018/1139 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 4 July 2018 on common rules in the field of civil aviation and establishing a European Union Aviation Safety Agency, and amending Regulations (EC) No 2111/2005, (EC) No 1008/2008, (EU) No 996/2010, (EU) No 376/2014 and Directives 2014/30/EU and 2014/53/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council, and repealing Regulations (EC) No 552/2004 and (EC) No 216/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council and Council Regulation (EEC) No 3922/91 ("hereinafter Regulation (EU) 2018/1139").
- Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2017/373 of 1 March 2017 laying down common requirements for providers of air traffic management/air navigation services and other air traffic management network functions and their oversight, (hereinafter Regulation (EU) 2017/373)¹;
- Commission Regulation (EU) 2015/340 of 20 February 2015 laying down technical requirements and administrative procedures relating to air traffic controllers' licences and certificates pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council, amending Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 923/2012 and repealing Commission Regulation (EU) No 805/2011, 6.3.2015 O.J. L 63/1 (hereinafter "Regulation (EU) 2015/340")².

4. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE

Acceptable means of compliance (AMC) issued by EASA³ are the usual means for organisations to comply with relevant regulatory requirements. Nevertheless, the regulations⁴ allow organisations to conform with requirements by applying also alternative means of compliance (AltMoC), on the assumption that these are approved by the competent authority (i.e. the NSA)⁵.

When an organisation opts to use an AltMoC, it shall, prior to implementing it, provide the NSA with its full description⁶ as well as the reason for opting to use it. The AltMoC description shall include any references to manuals or procedures that may be relevant, as well as an assessment demonstrating compliance with the requirements of the applicable regulation(s).

The organisation shall notify the NSA a minimum of 30 calendar days prior to the intended date of application of the AltMoC, using the template provided in Annex A.

The NSA shall review the proposed AltMoC and shall duly notify the organisation of its approval. Following its approval, the organisation may implement the AltMoC, as and when appropriate.

5. ENTRY INTO FORCE

This AIC shall enter into force on 1/3/2019.

4. DESCRIPTION OF THE AltMoC

These AltMoC contain the processes designed to provide assurance that a change to the ATM system or the introduction of a new ATM system can be implemented <u>acceptably safe</u>. Change must be managed so as to ensure that normal operations can take place and to minimise the risks in case of failures. To this effect, staff acceptability and readiness for the change must be ensured and, in addition, risks should be assessed and, if necessary, mitigated. Change will <u>not</u> be implemented, unless it can be successfully argued that the mitigations proposed provide an assurance for safety.

The detailed processes are collated and documented in a procedure titled "CYANS procedure for managing ATM functional changes" and is attached to this proposal.

5. PERIODICAL REVIEW OF THIS AltMoC

The proposed AltMoC will be reviewed, as a minimum, every two years so as to ensure that they remain relevant and valid.

6. COMPLIANCE ASSESSMENT OF THE AltMoC

The assessment demonstrating compliance of the proposed AltMoC with the requirements of the applicable regulation is presented in the next page.
