

Aeromedical Examiners

Medical examination for Flight Crew and Air Traffic Controllers are conducted in accordance with Part MED and Part ATCO MED requirements.

For revalidation/renewal of Class1, Class 2, Class 3, LAPL Medical Certificates and Cabin Crew Medical Reports, the applicant has to have a medical examination by an Aeromedical Examiner (AME), or the Aeromedical Center.

The applicant needs to make an appointment for the examination directly with an AME.

An AME is a qualified doctor certified to issue EASA medical certificates for Flight Crew, Air Traffic Controllers and Cabin Crew.

The applicant has to provide the AME/AeMC a complete medical history and, if required, results of medical examinations and tests conducted by the applicant's doctor or any other medical specialists.

If the applicant wears glasses or contact lenses, he/she needs to provide the AME/AeMC with the recent optician's prescription.

The applicant will be asked to provide a sample of urine, so ideally he/she should arrive at the examination with a full bladder.

Before the examination the applicant will need to complete the medical certificate application form (MED 160). This is a signed declaration containing the following:

- Medical history
- Whether he/she has had a medical examination before, by whom and the result of this examination
- Whether he/she has ever been assessed as unfit or had a medical certificate suspended or revoked

The examination may include:

- Medical history
- Physical examination
- Ophthalmological examination
- Audiogram
- Electrocardiogram (ECG)
- Hemoglobin blood test
- Urine test

A medical certificate can be issued by the AME/AeMC on the same day of the examination if all the requirements are met. If the requirements are not met, or further investigations are necessary, then a decision on fitness for a medical certificate may take longer.
