

ANNOUNCEMENT

AVAILABLE TRAFFIC RIGHTS

FOR BAHRAIN

The Department of Civil Aviation as the Competent Authority based on the Decision of the Minister of Communications and Works for the allocation of Scarce Traffic Rights with Third Countries, Statutory Instrument Act 406/2008, (Official Gazette of the Republic of Cyprus, Supplement III (I), No. 4312, dated 07/11/2008), and which was republished in the Official Journal of the EU (C56/37 dated 10.3.2009), informs European airlines (including air carriers of EEA countries) which are established in the Republic of Cyprus, that, based on the provisions of the relevant Bilateral Air Services Agreements and Arrangements between Cyprus and Bahrain, there are available traffic rights, without restrictions as to the number of airlines, frequencies and capacities on the following route:

1. Points in Cyprus / Bahrain / Points in Cyprus.

The airlines that are interested in operating the route should submit their interest to the Department of Civil Aviation at the following address:

Note 1: According to the written Arrangements between the two Aeronautical Authorities, the designated airlines are entitled to 5th freedom rights to intermediate points or points beyond the point of destination which are included in the attached list.
