

ANNOUNCEMENT

AVAILABLE TRAFFIC RIGHTS

FOR JAMAICA

The Department of Civil Aviation as the Competent Authority based on the Decision of the Minister of Transport, Communications and Works for the allocation of Scarce Traffic Rights with Third Countries, Statutory Instrument Act 406/2008, (Official Gazette of the Republic of Cyprus, Supplement III (I), No. 4312, dated 07/11/2008), and which was republished in the Official Journal of the EU (C56/37 dated 10.3.2009), informs European airlines (including air carriers of EEA countries) which are established in the Republic of Cyprus that, based on the provisions of the Air Services Agreement and arrangements between the Aeronautical Authorities of the Government of The Republic of Cyprus and The Government of Jamaica, there are available traffic rights, without any restrictions on the number of airlines, capacity, number of frequencies and aircraft types on the following routes:

Larnaka and/or Pafos - Any points in Jamaica- Larnaka and/or Pafos

The airlines that are interested in operating the routes should submit their interest to the Department of Civil Aviation at the following address:

Note 1: The designated airlines will be entitled to 5th freedom traffic rights in scheduled passenger and / or cargo services separately or in combination on the above route.

Note 2: The designated airlines of the Republic of Cyprus and Jamaica will be entitled to operate with full third, fourth, fifth and seventh freedom traffic rights in cargo services.
