General

This form is to be used for the skill test required for:

- (a) The initial issue of SP(A) Class Rating, or
- (b) The license variation (addition of different Class, Type or Instrument Rating)
- (c) The conversion of a license issued in compliance with the requirements of Annex 1 to the Chicago Convention by a third country
- (d) The acceptance of a valid Class or Type Rating issued by a third country to be endorsed on a valid Cyprus Part-FCL license.
